

Borrowing Digital Resources at Wanaque Library

Did you know that you can use your library card to download and access free eBooks, downloadable audiobooks, streaming movies and music, comic books, and thousands of current magazines, all for FREE?



HooplaDigital has thousands of eBooks and audiobooks for kids, teens and adults, plus a great selection of graphic novels, streaming music, and TV/movies! Items can be borrowed for 21 days at a time, and Wanaque library users can borrow up to 10 items per month.



Use Libby to access thousands of bestselling eBooks and downloadable audiobooks for all ages. You can also download and read the current issues of thousands of digital magazines, including popular titles such as *Women's Health*, *The Economist*, *Newsweek*, *Highlights for Kids*, *Good Housekeeping*, and many more. eBooks are loaned for 14 days; digital magazines and downloadable audiobooks are loaned for 21 days.

(Please note: the Libby app is not available in the Amazon App Store. Kindle Fire users can use the Overdrive app instead, which provides access to exactly the same content.)



Get started today! Here's how.

I have an Android device (such as an LG or Samsung) or an **Apple device** (an iPhone or iPad)

Head on over to your Google Play store (for Androids) or App Store (for Apple devices) and download the free Hoopla and Libby apps.



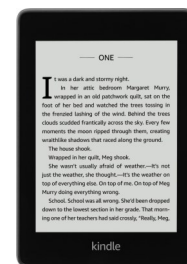
I have a Kindle Fire tablet

To access the library's digital resources on a Kindle Fire, download the Hoopla and Overdrive free apps from the Amazon App Store.



I have an Amazon Kindle eReader

A dedicated eReader (such as the Paperwhite or Oasis) can only display eBooks in a special Amazon-proprietary format. Unfortunately HooplaDigital items are not available in this format, but Overdrive/Libby has a large number of eBooks that you can borrow and download to your eReader in Kindle format. After you check out an eBook, if it's available to be borrowed in Kindle format, you'll see "Read Now with Kindle." You'll then be redirected to your Amazon account, where you can transfer the borrowed eBook to your Kindle
