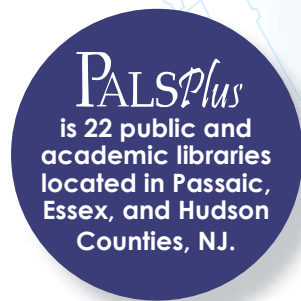

PALS Plus / May 2022

No cash? No problem. You can pay for fines & library services such as printing and faxing, if offered by your library, with a credit card, through "My Account" (minimum charge \$2.50)

### PAY BY CREDIT CARD

Need more time? No problem. Eligible items that do not have existing holds and have not reached their renewal limit will be automatically renewed at 5 AM on the day that they are due. Eligible materials can also be renewed in-library, by phoning any of the PALS Plus libraries, or through "My Account" at [catalog.palsplus.org](http://catalog.palsplus.org).

### RENEWING ITEMS

Most items can be checked out for a period of 21 days, with the exception of movies (7 days) and TV series (14 days). Some libraries loan special items such as cake pans, board games, or wireless hotspots, and those loan periods may vary.

A resident user with a valid library card from any PALS Plus library is entitled to borrowing privileges at other PALS Plus libraries. Lending restrictions may apply to PALS Plus borrowers based on local policies. A total of 75 items can be checked out on a library card at once.

### BORROWING

You can request materials that are currently checked out from your library or are from another PALS Plus library by placing a hold at your library or through "My Account" in the PALS Plus online catalog at [catalog.palsplus.org](http://catalog.palsplus.org).

### PLACING HOLDS

You can view your library account, search for materials in all PALS Plus libraries, place holds, renew materials, and manage your account by logging in with your library card on the PALS Plus online catalog at [catalog.palsplus.org](http://catalog.palsplus.org). Your PIN is set by your home library, so contact them if you need assistance with your PIN.

### ACCESS YOUR ACCOUNT / LIBRARY CATALOG

Your library card is valid for three years and must be renewed by visiting or contacting your home library.

Access our collections, discover, and explore. Register at your home library with photo identification and proof of residency to receive a free library card. You can use your library card in any of the 22 libraries that are part of the PALS Plus consortium. Additional in-person borrowing privileges are available through Open Borrowing at over 75 other libraries throughout New Jersey: [openborrowing.org](http://openborrowing.org). Hudson County library card holders may borrow from participating Hudson County libraries. Essex County library card holders may participate in Reciprocal Borrowing Libraries (ReBL). Limited borrowing privileges are available at most Open Borrowing, Hudson, and ReBL libraries.

PALS Plus is a library consortium comprised of 22 public and academic libraries in Passaic, Essex, and Hudson Counties, NJ. Our member libraries come together to share our physical collections, digital content in the form of eBooks, audiobooks, music, movies, and more.
